Laura Lambert mentioned USF had the Trans-Si berian Orchestra out to speak and they were given a 10,000 check. She will be contacting them for information.

## **Item 8: Announcements**

Mr Dell gave the options for the trip. Registration is due November 14<sup>th</sup> for the Inaugural Parade. If accepted we will have one month to pay for the trip. Last time they went the cost was \$100.00 per person. There were so many donations once the community heard Gaither was chosen to participate. The cost with no help will be around \$600-700 dollars. Riding a bus is the only option because of time to prepare. Leanne Duncan has found a Hotel in Alexandria. Mr Dell needs feed back. Deposits will need to be paid soon. Eric Hausman has connections with the Press to help get funding. Michelle Reyno has the letters form the last trip that they wrote to Congress. We have the right people to make this happen. Only one representative per State. Five or Six Bands applied last time. It is not always a band that they chose. Mr Dell will meet with the committee if we do not go to Washington. Other choices are Atlanta or Orlando this would be around Spring Break. He will try to make it as cheap as possible. St. Petersburg High is the Governors High School. Mr Dell will take all students on the Washington trip if this is where we go.

We will be having a silent action before our concerts this year. Mr Lugo has made a list for donations. A list was sent around. October 14<sup>th</sup> is our Fall concert and UT will be going us. We will be keeping this small. We will have a large auction at the Winter Concert we will advertise for this. Mr Dell suggested a raffle at the winter concert we could sell tickets during the football games (example large screen TV).

Mrs. Butler suggested selling flowers at the concert. Can we do this?

The welcome Committee last week was Brian, Sherry, Pat and Robin. Chamberlain was blown away by our hospitality. Brian roped off a section for there band, Sherry made a basket with baked goods, and Robin had freeze pops for the band. Chamberlain now wants to do this for Home games.
