Minutes

September 15, 2009

Meeting called to order by Mary Carter at 7:01 PM.

Financial Report:

- No financial report given as Ms. Sessions out sick and unable to pull report. Terri Clover stated that student account letters were given out today and most accounts are paid in full. She also stated there will be no reimbursements as this is illegal. Before purchases made there must be a PO and approval by Mr. Thompson. Mary Carter stated approx. \$1400.00 gross was made from first game concession stand.

Fundraising Report:

- Umbrella fundraiser; Heather Whorton stated umbrellas may not have been Ordered; she hasn't been able to contact anyone; wasn't finalized before Mr. Wilson left.
- 50/50 raffle denied – Angie handling.
- Bulldog cards; discussion on band taking left over bulldog cards from football team. They sell for \$10.00 each - \$3.00 will go to football team - \$7.00 to band. We will check on how many they have left and make sure we will not have to pay for any left over that is not sold.
- New ideas: dinner and movie – usually done for Valentines Day – tickets sell for \$1.00 – dinner is donated by Golden Coral and movie from local theater. Discussion made that we should send a “thank you for your support” to Golden Coral and movie theater. Also discussed selling Crispy Crème donuts. They sell for \$7.00/box - \$3.00 goes to Krispy Kreme - \$3.00 to student accounts and \$1.00 to general band fund. Mr. Schlazer could pick up and deliver to school. Cindy Warf will check on which Friday would be best. Scratch off cards; this was discussed in guard meeting held prior to booster Meeting. Student could earn \$80.00. Guards are planning a fundraiser to help pay for uniforms. On Oct. 16, they will have meal for Buckeye – guard parents are providing food. Discussion made that guard and booster meetings should be combined. Motion made to approve Krispy Kreme, bulldog cards, and scratch off cards for fundraisers by Cindy Warf, 2nd by Terri Clover.

Director's Report:

- Heather Whorton stated middle school is holding a fundraiser on Oct. 19 to Sell Christmas items. She has approx \$2600.00 in school account. Each time There is a middle school game, their band receives \$100.00 from concession stand sells. If she has a band need she can come to boosters to request funds. Mr. Schlazer stated high school band will be needing percussion items.
- Uniform Cleaning: it takes a full week to have all uniforms cleaned. They

- will be sent on October 5 and picked up October 12. Students can wear jeans and polo shirts to game in Gadsden on Oct. 9.
- Uniforms to Jefferson County: we will donate our old uniforms to Jefferson; will check with Mr. Thompson for approval so they can be removed from inventory. Motion made to donate uniforms by Pandora Padgett, 2nd by Cindy Warf.
 - Atlanta trip; \$219.00 + cost of transportation; 3 days, 2 nights. Package includes symphony, aquarium, 6 flags and more. Band will also have an opportunity to perform. Mr. Schlazer will check into cost of charter bus. Will try to keep cost no more than \$300.00. Cost includes breakfast and dinner. Mr. Schlazer will check with Mr. Thompson.
 - PRISM: tickets go on sale 9/29; concert on a Thursday night. Price of tickets is \$20 (\$18 for ticket + \$2 bus fee). Band directors of both schools will ask students by show of hands to estimate how many tickets to order.
 - Tarpon Springs Festival; Oct. 17; \$100.00; get PO for registration fee and ask for bus.
 - Forest Festival: \$250.00 + \$100.00 transportation fee. Mr. Schlazer will check on getting bus to bring kids back to school after parade so they may change out of uniforms.
 - Possible Festival: Oct. 31 (Halloween) @ Santa Fe High; will ask students if they want to participate.
 - Nov. 6: plan to have 8th graders play in stand at game.
 - FBA: Nov. 7 – school pays for
 - FMBC: Nov. 21; Tropicana field @ St. Pete. Mr. Schlazer will check to see if students want to attend. If so, may invite 8th graders to attend also.
 - Alumni will play in stands at homecoming game.
 - Dallas Brass: \$10.00 for tickets; Dec. 1 in Live Oak school.
 - Tri-state festival of winds: Dec. 3-6, booster pays.
 - Steinhatchee River Parade: Dec. 5 (?)
 - Concession stand: supplies picked up. Mary Carter stated she is having trouble getting someone to cook for Friday game. Mr. Schlazer will send out e-mails requesting help. Cups have been donated.
 - Fancy Folders: nice folders to hold student's music; Music Masters will be giving a price.
 - Volunteer form: will check to see who all has turned one in – only need to Do this if you are chaperoning for away games.

Old Business

Convention in January 6-9 is very beneficial. Will check back with Mr. Dyal In November to see if hotel will be paid for. Last year district paid for hotel. Boosters pay for students to go (middle and high school). Usually 2 are Picked from high school and 1 from middle school.
