Meeting called to order by Stacie Coxwell, President at 7:08 P.M.

Minutes read by Secretary Terri Clover. Motion to approve minutes as read by Sherisa Anderson and 2nd by Paul Wiggins, motion passed.

Financial Report: Paul Wiggins

- December 31, 2008 balance \$ 8,566.37 including student accounts
- Money market balance \$10,563.01

Fundraising Report: Cindy Warf

- Valentine Dinner and a movie ticket sale at Walmart on Saturday. Did not have many show up, but sold some tickets.

Director's Report: Brett Wilson, Heather Hayes not in attendance

- Auxiliary solo/ensemble was Friday Feb. 6 – auxiliary performed well
- Saturday February 7, Middle and High school students had Solo/ensemble at FAMU , (7) middle school students participated and received ratings of Excellent and Superior and (1) high school student participated with a rating of Superior.
- Mock FBA will be held at Madison HS on Feb. 19
- May 16 – Arts Festival at Forest Capital park
- Spring Trip Itinerary information handed out. We need one more fundraiser before trip. The candy worked well last year and we will schedule it for March 9.
- Orlando trip meetings will be Friday, March 20, 5:30 PM at TCHS and Friday April 17, 4:30 at MCHS. These will be for band only due to combined performance. Auxiliary will not need to attend.
- If band receives a Superior at FBA, State FBA performance will be the same week as spring trip and will be held in Panama City.
- Umbrella fundraiser – if we want to place an order for next year, it needs to be done this month to obtain the best price. 300 umbrellas cost \$645 for a profit of \$2,565 or 57%. Our cost is \$1,935. Paul Wiggins makes a motion to go ahead with purchase of umbrellas based upon financial report feasibility. Motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cindy Warf, motion passed.
- Timpani repairs – appx. Cost per timpani \$255, (4) need to be repaired. The alternative is to replace them at \$4,000 each. Motion to repair (2) at this time based on a \$300 repair fee by Paul Wiggins. Motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sherisa Anderson, motion passed.

- Guitar Hero Fundraiser – March 14 in TCHS gym, open to all district employees and students. Concessions will be available, \$5 charge to play, \$1 to watch. Must bring own guitar.
- Budget: The boosters need to start looking at a budget for next year. Mr. Wilson is hoping to sit down with the principals at TCHS and TCMS and determine what the school district might be able to provide next year so that we have a good idea of what we need to come up with on our own and what is realistic in terms of things we can do next year.
- Band Banquet: Saturday May 23, we need to start ordering awards to ensure timely delivery. March meeting we will need to put a committee together to organize the banquet.

Old Business: (These items were held over from November meeting)

- Point system for volunteering during the school year. Cathy Wiggins and Sarah Bayes will recruit members to help with this committee.
- Executive committee will need to get together and work on incorporating Middle School into by-laws. Terri Clover will give copies of TCHS by-laws and TCMS by-laws to Mr. Wilson to post on website for booster input. This will be discussed at a later date.
- Nominating committee will need to be formed in March; according to By-Laws this committee will not include any of the existing officers. We need to have representation from the Middle School on committee.
