BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

Minutes

October 14, 2008

Meeting called to order by Stacie Coxwell, President at 7:13 P.M. Minutes read by Secretary Terri Clover, motion to accept minutes by Paul Wiggins, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ruth Ann Whitfield. Motion carried to accept minutes as read.

Financial Report: Paul Wiggins

- Balance \$6,457.00 (not including money market) Financially we are doing well.
- Budget report distributed for 6/1/08 – 9/30/08. Items discussed and motion to accept budget as submitted by Eric Scott, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ruth Ann Whitfield. Noted that trash can purchase for Spring concert was higher than originally anticipated.
- Auxiliary parents Mark and Dana Southerland and Angie Clark asked how the auxiliary funds raised separately from the band were distributed. Mr. Wiggins noted that at this time those funds had been deposited into the school account and were not under the booster's jurisdiction. Further discussion regarding incorporating all monies raised to be deposited into the booster account so that distribution can be accounted for in regards to sponsors, uniform orders, instructors, and equipment.
- Money for students nominated to attend Festival of Winds and Tri-State Honor bands was not put into budget. Mr. Scott noted that if students are selected to attend, the boosters should support them also and not only those selected for the state small schools and middle school honor band.

Director's Report: Brett Wilson, Miss Hays (unable to be present, band practice)

- Tarpon Springs Competition schedule and Forest Festival schedule have been posted to website.
- List of students selected for Honor bands should be available within the next week

Old Business:

- Angie Clark has been contacting alumni for Christmas concert performance. Feedback has been that they would rather perform on the field at homecoming. She does not know how many will be performing at Christmas.
- Point system for volunteering – not enough members present to help with the committees, will table till a later date.
- Will make changes to By-Laws to incorporate Middle School program at a later date.

New Business:

- Angie Clark asked about having a Raffle fundraiser at the Christmas Concert. She had given the band a Debbie's Jewels certificate and a Certificate from Wilson's Bait and Tackle for a Rod and Reel to be used. They have not been used to date and we need to either have a raffle or return the items. Will discuss further at the November meeting.
- Paul Wiggins presented the option of having a dinner fundraiser before the Christmas Concert. Will discuss further at the November meeting.
- Question raised about giving students some lunch money for the Tarpon Springs trip to ensure that all students eat that day. Money is already in the budget for this expenditure.
