Financial Report: Paul Wiggins

- Balance \$7,942.92 (not including money market)

- Paul will check with Pepsi on cost of soda, currently \$90 a box and we have gone through 2 boxes.

Director's Report: Brett Wilson (see attached agenda for band)

- Discussion regarding Boosters to supplying 50% down payment on concert Dress order with remaining balance due at delivery. Motion for boosters to pay the 50% up front by Paul Wiggins, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cindy Warf. (The amount will be put back from student accounts)
- Dr. Thompson will be here Dec. 9-13, 2008, cost of hotel will be \$116 per night (\$454.00) plus the flight cost. Other area bands have been invited, asking for a \$100 donation to help offset costs.
- FMEA conference – Boosters will table discussion of this until directors discuss further with their schools.

- Charter bus cost will be \$1200 to \$1335
